IMPORTANT DISCLOSURES

If you are owed federal tax refund(s), you have a right to choose how you will receive the refund(s). There are several options available to you. Some options cost money and some options are free. Please read about these options below.

You can file your federal tax return(s) electronically or by paper and obtain your federal tax refund(s) <u>directly</u> from the Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") <u>for free.</u> If you file your tax return(s) electronically, you can receive refund checks directly from the IRS through the U.S. Postal Service in 21 to 28 days from the time you file your tax return(s) or the IRS can deposit your refund(s) directly into your bank account in less than 21 days from the time you file your tax return(s) unless there are delays by the IRS. If you file a paper return through the U.S. Postal Service, you can receive refund checks directly from the IRS through the U.S. Postal Service, you can receive refund checks directly from the IRS through the U.S. Postal Service in 6 to 8 weeks from the time the IRS receives your return(s) or the IRS can deposit your refund(s) directly into your bank account in 6 to 8 weeks from the time the IRS receives your return(s). If you file your tax return(s) electronically and select the RPS, the IRS will deposit your refund(s) with Bank. Upon Bank's receipt of your refund(s), Santa Barbara Tax Products Group, LLC, a division of Green Dot Corporation, a Delaware corporation, a processor, will deduct from your federal refund(s) the RPS fee, any fees charged by TurboTax for the preparation and filing of your tax return(s) and any other amounts authorized by you and disburse the balance of your refund proceeds to you. Unless there are unexpected delays, federal refunds are received in less than 21 days from the time you file your tax return(s) electronically. However, if your return(s) contains Earned Income Tax Credit or Additional Child Tax Credit, the IRS will issue your refund(s) no earlier than February 15, 2022.

We will do our best to escalate the return of your federal tax refunds to the IRS and you will need to work with the IRS directly for disbursement.

8.
