SAFETY GUIDELINES



WARNING - Do not crush, disassemble, reverse polarity or install incorrectly, incinerate, or mutilate the lithium-ion battery. Do not expose to fire or temperatures above 160 °F (71 °C). The battery can vent, rupture, or explode, releasing toxic material which may cause serious injury or death. In case material is released or spilled, evacuate and allow vapors to dissipate. Increase ventilation and do not inhale vapors. Notify safety personnel of release or spills.






DUAL PUSH-TO-TALK (PTT) OPERATION




