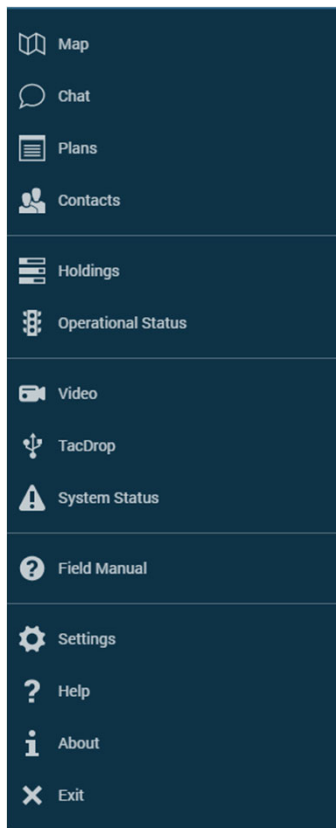




Main Menu: This menu lets you switch between the different main parts of the application and includes Settings and About.

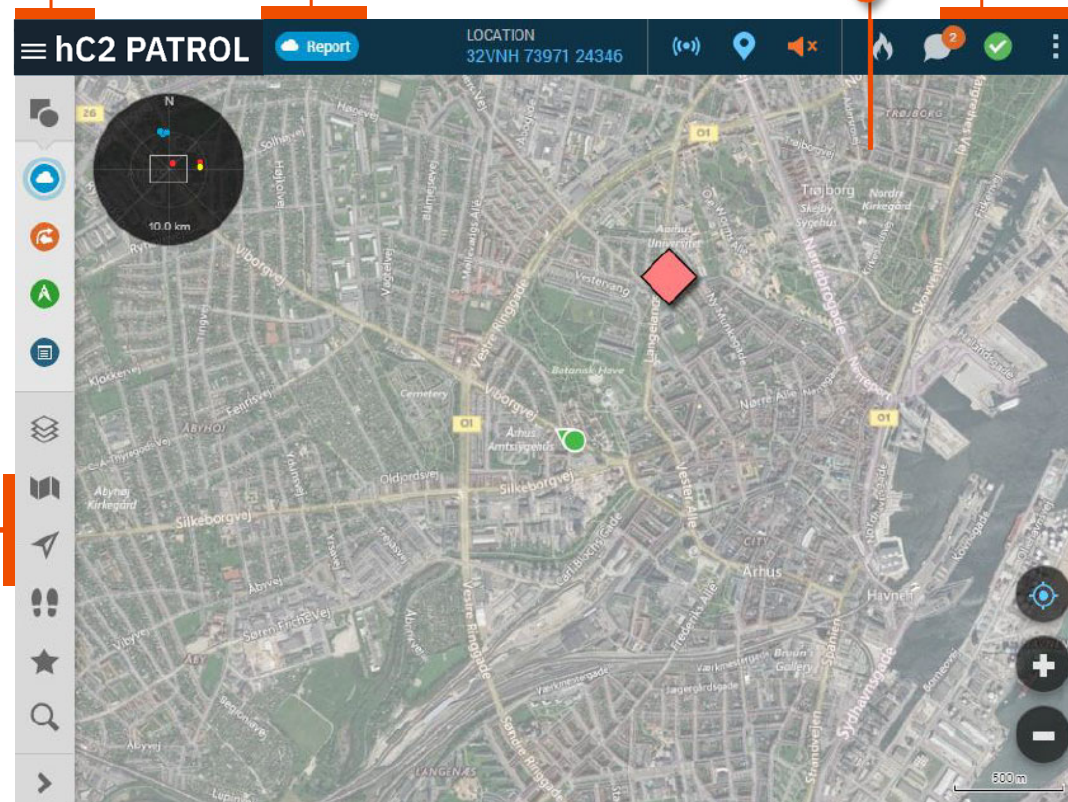
Plans

Mode Display: Tells you which mode you are currently in. Report (default), Command, Geo Tools, or Plans.

The Map: Visualizes the area of operations and lets you display and interact with symbols and graphics.

Top Bar: Displays your own location, call sign, map scale, Status icons, quick access to available Hot Buttons, a Chat Icon with an Unread Messages counter, and a More button which includes Toggle Size, Find Location, Show Area of Interest and Minimize Application. Depending on the size of your device, some of these icons may spill into the More menu.

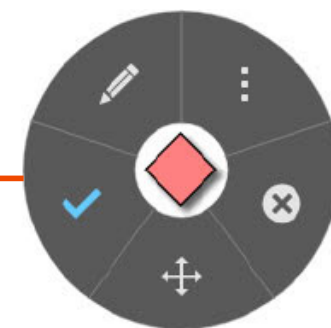
Chat and System Status are both easy shortcuts for opening the Apps.



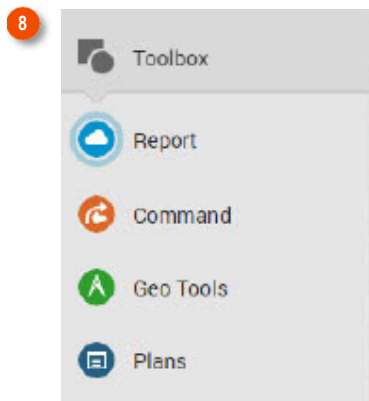
Map Toolbar: This vertical toolbar lets you add data to the map and select which data to display. You can control if the toolbar should include only icons or panel names as well, by using the arrow in the lower left corner. Tap a tool to open the corresponding panel.



Map Buttons: Besides zoom in and out, you have a tristate button available that allows you to center on own position and optionally rotate the map in the direction you are moving.



Action Wheel: Long press on the map for easy access to reporting. You can drag the Action Wheel around by the lower handle. If you tap the handle, it changes to a different move state which allows you to tap on a map location to move it there. You can also use the Action Wheel to update, bookmark, or delete existing objects. Just tap on object to trigger it and use the More button for additional options. If you tap on a multi-point object you will get an action toolbar at the bottom of the screen instead.

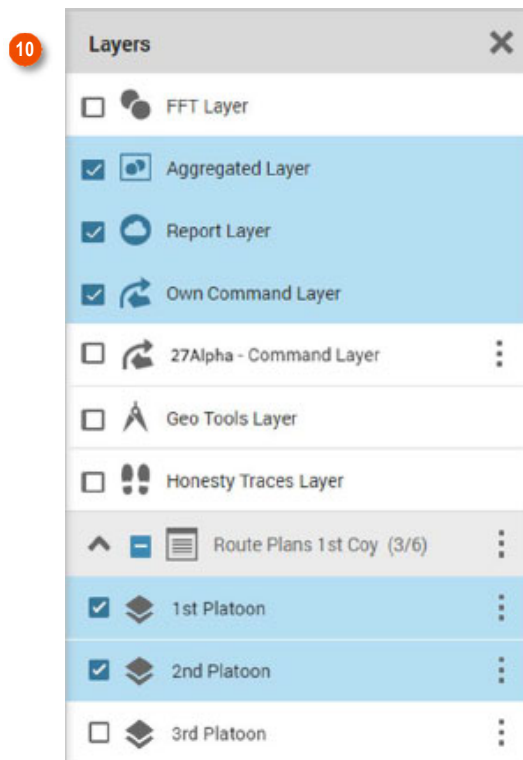
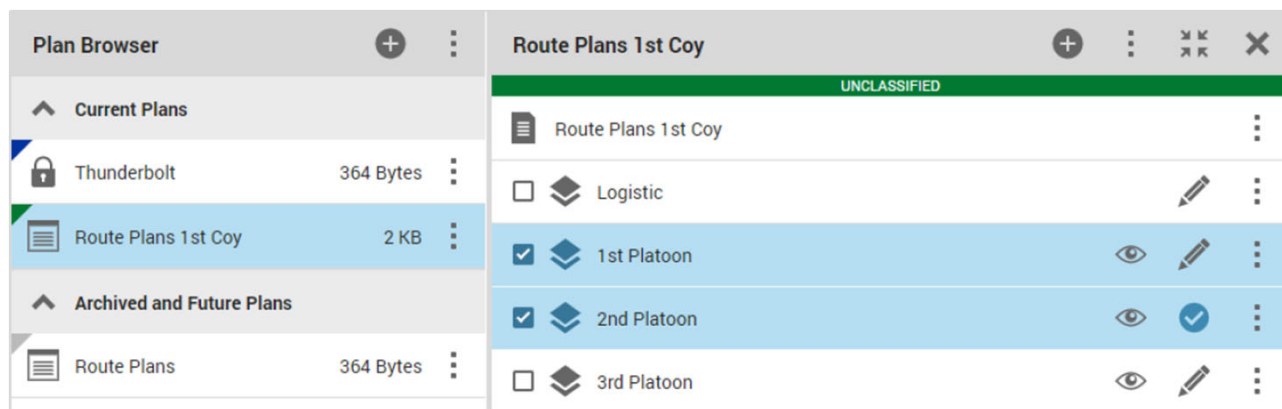


Toolbox: Gives you different objects or symbols you can add to the map depending on the mode you are in: Report, Command, Geo Tools, or Plans. Each mode corresponds to an active layer.



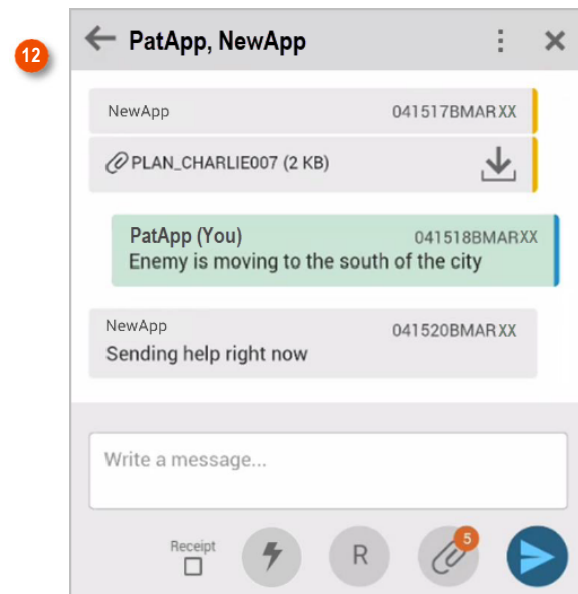
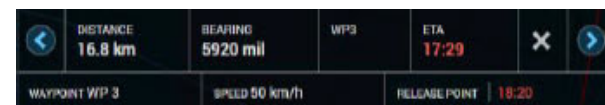
The active layer is the layer you work on and only one layer can be active at a time. The active layer is displayed in the Toolbox and in the Top Context Box when you add elements to the map.

- 9 Plans:** Lets you view the content of all plans and edit any unlocked plans.
- The Plus icon allows you to add files of various types.
 - Use the Pen icon to set a layer to the active layer and open the Plans Toolbox. Tap on the text element to read or edit it.



Layers: Lets you select which layers to display, and lets you delete received command layers. You can add plan layers for quick access and editing. By default, no plan layers are added, but a list of plans located in Current Plans is visible.

- 11 Execute Route:** Lets you select which of the available routes to execute. A panel will assist you in navigating the route along with a compass at the bottom of the screen.



- 12 Chat:** Open Chat either from the Main Menu or from the Chat icon in the Top Bar.
- Tap the More icon to open the **Chat Rooms** dialog. A list of available chat rooms is visible. When you join a chat room, it is added to the list of conversations.
- Check the rooms you want to join.
 - Uncheck the rooms you want to leave.
- Tap on the plus icon to create a new private message.

For both chat rooms and private messages, you can use quick messages, specify a precedence, request a read receipt, and attach honesty traces, images, plans, formatted messages, video snapshots, or various files.
