
2022 FD PLANING Meeting - UPDATES 5/5/22

Begin station setup by mid-afternoon Friday. Goal is to perform Friday evening network, computer, and on-air testing to check for inter-station interference in time to resolve Saturday morning.

 - PH/Digital: IC-7610 (K2TER)
 - VHF/Digital: (K2TER)
 - GOTA/Digital: IC-7610 (K2DH)
 - TBD: SATELLITE: : IC-9700 K2DH? ant M2 w tracking controller W2FU??
 - GROUND RODS
 - Site-wide grounding plan (Generator, CW, PH/VHF, GOTA, SAT) [AC2RL?]
 - In-line GFCI dongles; locate at tent end (AC2RL? purchased 5 2019)
 - Ground rod driver (post pounder), sledge (**K2GC**)
 - ground rod puller (TBD; K2GC?)

• EQUIPMENT – COMPUTERS/NETWORK

- Computer/Network Team: (K2GC)
- Wired Ethernet, network cabling (K2GC)
 - Network hub at ADMAR generator (K2GC)
 - GPS time standard at ADMAR generator [K2GC?]
 - VHF and GOTA HF stations are <u>NOT to be on the network</u>.
 - N1MM+ computer logging for CW, Phone, Digital stations
 - Logging discussed re whether N1MM+ logs all (HF + Digital) contacts or split between WSJT-X Log and N1MM+
 - Does N1MM+ need to be turned off when running Digital?
 - If so, need procedure

MONITORS

- 19-inch flat screen preferable
- BACKUPS At least two if available; If extra needed, check with W2BSN?
 N2BEG?, K2GC?

GENERAL

- <u>STAGING</u>: All computers and network, including GPS, to be pre-staged; include as many transceivers as possible
- No on-site PC configuration changes allowed by operators network team only;

consider PC password protection

- Have extra VGA/HDMI monitor cables on site (K2GC)
- Logging (K2TER, K2GC, someone else?)
 - **HF**: All PCs must run exact same version of N1MM+
 - FT8: WSJT-X LOG???
- N1MM+ multi-multi master file must be set up and copied to all units (TBD)
- Updated Call History file to be installed (TBD)
- Need knowledgeable N1MM+ users available at least two hours before start to troubleshoot any start-up issues. (TBD)
- USB-Serial cable s/w must be available by user on thumb drive (NO internet access)

FIELD DAY OPERATIONS

STATIONS

- Spectator NOISE ABATEMENT <u>signs</u> need to be posted at all stations (TBD)
- Captains responsible for operator training, scheduling, band management, interference reconciliation, etc.
- Station **OPERATING** captains:

CW: N2BEGPHONE: K2TERVHF: K2TER, KV2X

GOTA/Dig: K2MTH, W3OAB

DIGITAL: K2DH (which stations? Or is it a matter of when?)

• SAT??? K2DH

- Operator scheduling (Station captains)
 - Assigned ops may request changes with the station captain

TOPICS (These should be at a live computer (large monitor if possible) with N1MM+ running): Where?

- o N1MM+/K3 functions for CW
- N1MM+ pre-recorded messages (CW TBD, PH TBD)
- N1MM+ Inter-station TALK function (Ctl-E) (TBD)
- How use Call History (2 minutes! But invaluable if you don't know) (TBD)
- Beverage switching (TBD)
- o FT8 (at Phone and GOTA stations) (TBD)
 - Basic CQ "run" operation
 - PH/FT8 switching (both functions are built into each rig)

Consider covering at the regular club mtg the Tues before FD

- OVERALL STRATEGY (ALL TBD)
 - General
 - CQ is default for all stations/modes (including digital)
 - Emphasize 40 and 20 —each have 4X more stations than 80 (lots of clubs shut down at night)
 - Phone/Digital strategy
 - Maximize phone rate, CQ only
 - Convert to FT8 when slow, twice the points
 - CW strategy --
 - Band hop between 80/40
 - GOTA/Digital strategy + VHF/Digital strategy
 - Regularly check FT8 (if FT8 knowledgeable coaches available)
 - During "off hours," optimize digital as long as possible
 - Gather station QSO data at immediate end for on-site preliminary results (ΤΒD)

- FOOD (ALL TBD)
 - Publish food details on reflector prior to FD and on on-site bulletin board (TBD)
 - Friday breakfast (7:00) Nutcracker restaurant on your own
 - Friday lunch (Noon) Wegmans wrap tray (TBD)
 - Friday pizza (5:00) (TBD); club subsidized
 - Saturday breakfast (7:00) Nutcracker restaurant on your own
 - Saturday lunch (Noon) Wegmans Sub tray (TBD)
 - Saturday dinner (5:00) Pasta dinner (N2JQR?) W3OAB??? Otherwise, what?
 - Sunday breakfast (7:00) Bagels, muffins, Danish, coffee (TBD; club subsidized)
 - Sunday lunch (Noon)-- Burgers, Hot Dogs, Condiments, Chips (TBD; club subsidized)
 - Grill (TBD); charcoal from KD2TBI
 - Condiments likely available from Wegmans trays
 - Coffee throughout FD (TBD; club subsidized)
 - Use club urns to have "regular" coffee available, esp during night shifts
 - Bottled water, ice throughout FD (TBD; club subsidized)
 - Repeat item: Do we want/need a refrigerator?
 - Food orders/payment (where applicable) to be taken on-site (Food captain, assistant)
 - Food cost reimbursements: submit receipts to treasurer/designee on-site or within a week post-FD
- BONUSES (every one of these is equal to 25 CW/Digital or 50 PH contacts!)

Overall BONUS coordinator: An overall coordinator to oversee all of this from pre-FD planning to post-FD submission would be a huge contribution
